"This was one of the larger birds within the catch, caught on the first catch on the 16th January (the other catch being the 18th, and both at High Kelling near the rugby club), weighing 2.65kg. The bird departed from the catch location two days after tagging. It headed towards the Wash Estuary where it spent the next 21 days foraging on coast fields and inland fields to the west and south of the Wash with some use of the intertidal area of the estuary, presumably for roosting at night. On the 7th February, the bird made a cross-country flight to the West Coast of the UK. The bird then headed northward making a series of short stop-overs (i.e. few days) on the West Coast (Ribble Estuary) and in an inland location in Dumfries and Galloway. On the 16th February, the bird arrived in the Midlothian where it spent the rest of the winter. During that time, home range appeared to be small with a reliance on very few fields for either foraging or roosting. On the 15th April, the bird made a seemingly non-stop flight to Iceland".

Red Kite

New information this month*.

Wing-tagging of Red Kites commenced in East Anglia in 2015. Those first ringed by Phil Littler in North Norfolk were fitted with **black tags** and *white* codes (the same 2 alpha/numeric on each wing) but *white* tags with black codes are now being used*. White-tailed Eagle

Five colour-ringed individuals fitted with satellite transmitters have been seen and satellite plots revealed that another bird has also visited the Square. They come from a project run by the Roy Dennis Wildlife Foundation in partnership with Forestry England. Nestlings are collected under licence, issued by Scottish Natural Heritage, from nests in Scotland and are translocated to the Isle of Wight in late June. They are then held in a quiet, confidential, location for approximately four-eight weeks before being released. Food (mainly fish) is provided close to the release site during the autumn and winter before the young eagles become independent. The Natural England licence permits the release of up to 60 juvenile eagles on the Isle of Wight over a five-year period from 2019. The first six juveniles were translocated to the Isle of Wight in late June 2019 and all were successfully released in August. A further seven youngsters were translocated and released in 2020 and 12 in 2021. Ringed as a male nestling in 2020 in Sutherland (W Scotland).

Movements Translocated to the Isle of Wight in June. After release he eventually left the island flying west to Land's End during October. He wintered near Chard in the south of Somerset, living in a relatively large core area of 140 km², predominantly to the north and south-west of Chard. He flew to the north Somerset coast just to the south of Burnham-on-Sea on 4/2/21 and then lingered to the south of the village of Mark in the Somerset Levels until 7/2/21 when he returned to the Chard area. He headed south-east to the Devon coast near Bridport on 10/2/21. He then flew north on 12/2/21 spending all day 14/2/21 in and around Copley Wood to the north of Somerton in central Somerset. On 15-16/2/21 he continued north-east and flew 120 km across Somerset, and Wiltshire to West Berkshire. He then lingered between Newbury and Reading before making a brief visit to Theale Lagoon just to the south-west of Reading on 19/2/21 and spending the rest of the day in the Thames valley. He moved further north on 20/2/21 and lingered in the Chilterns in south-east Oxfordshire for three days before making another concerted move to the north-east on 23/2/21, flying 86 km through Buckinghamshire and then Hertfordshire before roosting in woodland two miles east

of Baldock. Next day he flew a further 49 km further north-east into Cambridgeshire before covering another 47 km (29 miles) on 26/2/21, skirting to the east of Newmarket and then crossing into north-west Suffolk. He lingered to the south-west of Thetford for two days before heading further north into the Brecks in Norfolk on 28/2/21. After a week in the Brecks he flew a 105 km circuit to the North Norfolk coast on 7/3/21, flying over Blakeney, Salthouse and Kelling between 12:40 and 13:10 before heading back SW. Seen during the day at Walsey Hills NOA and south of the Kelling Triangle. He left Norfolk 20/3/21 flying SE to the Suffolk coast where he stayed until 29/3/21 before flying back northwards to the Norfolk Broads. On 2/4/21 he returned to Suffolk and visited the Essex coast briefly on 4/4/21. On 5/4/21 he flew south into Kent and 7km out into the English Channel before returning to Kent. The following morning 6/4/21 he again flew 7km out to sea again but returned once more. In the afternoon, however, the wind was perfect and he flew the 47km across to Boulogne-sur-mer in 47mins and become the first individual from this project to make it across to mainland Europe. He then flew 176km SE in France to roost near the village of Duilly (Picardy). On 7/4/21 he started a long journey NE roosting S of Liege in Belgium. The following day 8/4/21 he travelled through the Netherlands into Germany. He remained on the south side of the River Elbe until 18/4/21 when he moved into the northerly German state of Schleswig-Holstein. He moved into Denmark on 25/4/21 and on 28/4/21 reached the most northerly point of his explorations, the south side of Ringkøbing Fjord. He remained on the Danish coast until 29/5/21 when he returned south through Germany, the Netherlands and Belgium before crossing into France on 13/6/21. He lingered there for a week before returning north and reaching Germany on 25/6/21. He stayed there favouring the River Eide Estuary until 24/7/21. He then crossed the border into the Netherlands where he has been favouring the Wadden Sea coast and the Ems Estuary on the German border. He eventually headed back south to France and after three failed attempts crossed the Channel back into Kent 10/11/21 and then flew up to the Isle of Sheppey. He crossed the channel again on 3/4/22 and visited many of the sites he visited the previous year in the Netherlands, Germany and Denmark but also travelled further north into Southern Sweden 28/4/22-1/5/22. Photographs revealed that he had lost his right foot. He returned to England crossing the Channel on 20/9/22. He then flew N to visit W Norfolk again remaining there to the end of October. He then flew SW to Somerset before visiting Poole Harbour on 26/12/22. He returned to the Isle of Wight for the first time since his release 9-13/1/23 but was seen off by the resident pair of eagles and visited Wiltshire then Poole Harbour.

He met up with female G466 that was also translocated to the Isle of Wight in 2020 on 20/1/23 and they have been together since then. Their favoured area of 125 square km is centred on Poole Harbour and stretches from Wareham Forest south to Kimmeridge. They have been seen making regular courtship flights.

Ringed as a male nestling in 2020 in W Scotland.

Movements Translocated to the Isle of Wight in June. After release he eventually left the island and spent his first winter on the Cornwall-Devon border. His core area encompassed approximately 22 km² between Bude and Holsworthy, but on occasions he did make longer exploratory flights into other parts of Cornwall and Devon and on 18/1/21 into Somerset. On 16/2/21 he started moving eastwards through Devon and left that county on 23/2/21 flying 53 km north-east to the Quantock Hills (Somerset). He spent the following day a mile north of Hawkridge Reservoir then on 25/2/21 flew north to the coast just to the south of Bridgwater Bay, headed east over Salisbury Plain and roosted near Tilshead (Wiltshire) after flying 97 km

05/12/2023

(60 miles). He headed north-east over subsequent days. He roosted just to the south of Burbage (Wiltshire) on 26/2/21 then flew a further 58 km to the Chilterns (Oxfordshire). He continued to follow the Chilterns ridge north-east over the next few days, passing directly over Tring on 1/3/21 and crossing into Bedfordshire later that afternoon. He slowly made his way north through Bedfordshire over subsequent days and on 5/3/21 crossed the border into Cambridgeshire and arrived at Graham Water remaining there until the morning of 9/3/21. Visited the Cley Square 23/3/21 being seen at Bayfield, Kelling Quags, Cley Marshes and Walsey Hills. He remained in East Anglia, favouring the Ouse Washes and the north Norfolk coast until 14/4/21 when he headed back SW into Herefordshire but then the following day decided to fly back north through Shropshire, Cheshire and Merseyside to the Yorkshire Dales. He continued north into Scotland on 18/4/21 reaching the southern Cairngorms National Park on 21/4/21 before turning back south and returning to England on 23/4/21. He remained in the Cheviot Hills for a couple of weeks then returned north to southern Scotland on 11/5/21 to spend the summer there apart from a brief visit to the Cheviots in June. He flew back south into Northumberland on 11/9/21 before heading back into Scotland and crossing the Firth of Forth again. He then spent some more time in the Scottish borders before making his way south, briefly stopping off in Yorkshire and Lincolnshire and arrived in Norfolk mid-January. A bird with a transmitter that was seen and photographed at Cley Marshes on 28/1/22 was confirmed by the Foundation to have been this bird. He later then travelled south to Cambs 13+14/2/22. He then travelled to the South Downs in W Sussex and appeared to be showing signs of forming a pair bond with female G405. He arrived back at the Isle of Wight 19/3/22. He was seen together with his partner G405 in W Sussex from mid-June to the end of the year and the pair became territorial and showing encouraging courtship behaviour. The pair successfully raised a male chick in 2023.

Ringed as a female nestling in 2021 on the Isle of Mull.

Movements Translocated to the Isle of Wight in 2021. Seen at Felbrigg, Cromer shortly before a sighting in the Square at Kelling 15/4/22. She subsequently headed further W to Hunstanton. She then flew back E to the Suffolk coast before flying inland into Cambridgeshire on 19/4/22. She was in Dorset in May 2022.

Left leg: black ring with white code G542.

Right leg: Metal ring no. 221342. Fitted with a satellite transmitter

Ringed as a female nestling in 2021 at Wiay on the Isle of Uist.

Movements Translocated to the Isle of Wight then released in 2021. She was in the Firth of Forth area in mid-April 2022 then Caithness in mid-July 2022. She was in Norfolk in mid-September and early October before travelling back north and visiting Northumberland. She was back in Norfolk in mid-November and visited the Cley Square on 7+8/12/22.

Fitted with a satellite transmitter. *Seen* Bayfield Estate 18/7(RPr)

Ringed as a female nestling in 2021 on the island of Lewis (Outer Hebrides).

Movements Translocated to the Isle of Wight in 2021 and spent much of her first winter there. She was in Hampshire 18/12/21 and also visited Dorset. She was back on the Isle of Wight in the first week of April. She spent much of the remainder of April in Poole Harbour. She headed north 4/5/22 following the east coast of England and after visiting Cley Marshes and Blakeney Harbour 7/5/22 reached the Cleveland coast on 9/5/22 before heading back south inland. She was at Middleton RSPB (Staffs) on 15/5/22 and arrived back in Poole Harbour on 27/5/22. She had remained there together with two males to at least 2/10/22 but was displaced later in the year by an older female. She is now spending time in Cranborne Chase with a male G812 that was released in 2021. She does continue to make visits to Poole Harbour though and was seen there 21/5/23. After visiting Bayfield she visited the King's Lynn area and then headed south past Milton Kenes.

Marsh Harrier

Well over 200 Marsh Harriers have been fitted with wing-tags in North Norfolk since 2011 and individuals have been sighted in the UK from Cornwall to as far north as Aberdeen. There have also been sightings in Ireland, Belgium, Germany, Spain, Portugal and the Canaries. These birds originally had lime tags with a code of two letters/numbers. The tags in fact look pale green, a little darker than most lime leg rings. The first series of codes beginning A were in *white* but all subsequent wing-tags have the code in **black**. **Orange** tags with **black** codes are now being used.

In 2015 the RSPB decided to restart colour-ringing chicks and also adults as the UK population was not increasing as had been hoped for. The new scheme again has four tibia rings but the lower right scheme identifier is now a lime ring with a **black E** engraved on it. Anyone seeing one of these birds is asked to report the sighting to Jennifer.Smart@rspb.org.uk

and she will reply with details of the bird ASAP.

Unfortunately the 2015 breeding season was a poor one. Some adults were successfully ringed but only four chicks were and it is feared that none of these chicks survived. From 2017 birds were "headed-started" by RSPB/WWT. Eggs were taken from the nests of Black-tailed Godwits at Nene Washes (Cambs) then hatched at Welney with the resulting youngsters being released. These released birds all had a dark **Green** ring as the upper right tibia ring in 2017 and a total of 26 were released at Welney. In 2018 the upper right ring for the "head-started" birds was **White** and a total of 38 birds were released, 23 at Welney and 15 at Nene Washes. In 2019 the upper right ring for the "head-started" birds was **Black** and a total of 48 birds were released. No birds were head-started in 2020 due to the coronavirus lockdown. In 2021 the upper right ring for the "head-started" birds was **Yellow** and a total of 43 birds were released. In 2022, the final year of the project, the upper right ring for the "head-started" birds was **Blue** and 51 more fledglings were released making the total for the project 206.

All birds that have been ringed in recent years have been fitted with a PIT tag attached to the tarsus (usually the left) that does not have the metal ring. This "helps to tie a few extra adult identities to nests for some birds which are difficult to observe walking on to nests".
