Hedgehog	<i>Erinaceus europaeus</i>	common
Mole	<i>Talpa europaea</i>	abundant
Common Shrew	<i>Sorex araneus</i>	common
Pygmy Shrew	<i>Sorex minutus</i>	common
Water Shrew	<i>Neomys fodiens</i>	scarce
Rabbit	<i>Oryctolagus cuniculus</i>	common; formerly abundant, but has declined drastically in recent years
Brown Hare	<i>Lepus europaeus</i>	abundant
Red Squirrel	<i>Sciurus vulgaris</i>	formerly common, now extinct; last confirmed sighting Kelling Triangle 19th May 1974
Grey Squirrel	<i>Sciurus carolinensis</i>	abundant
Bank Vole	<i>Myodes glareolus</i>	common
Field Vole	<i>Microtus agrestis</i>	abundant
Water Vole	<i>Arvicola amphibius</i>	scarce
Harvest Mouse	<i>Micromys minutus</i>	scarce
Wood Mouse	<i>Apodemus sylvaticus</i>	abundant
House Mouse	<i>Mus musculus</i>	scarce
Brown Rat	<i>Rattus norvegicus</i>	common
Coypu	<i>Myocastor coypus</i>	a common introduction in the mid 20th Century, but eradicated in about 1988
Feral Cat	<i>Felis catus</i>	rare
Fox	<i>Vulpes vulpes</i>	scarce
Badger	<i>Meles meles</i>	scarce
Otter	<i>Lutra lutra</i>	scarce
Stoat	<i>Mustela erminea</i>	scarce
Weasel	<i>Mustela nivalis</i>	scarce
Polecat	<i>Mustela putorius</i>	a scarce recent arrival (first recorded in 2016 having spread from the west)
Polecat-Ferret	<i>Mustela putorius x M. furo</i>	rare
Feral Ferret	<i>Mustela furo</i>	rare
American Mink	<i>Neovison vison</i>	formerly scarce 20th Century introduction, now rare due to trapping since 2000
Red Deer	<i>Cervus elaphus</i>	common
Fallow Deer	<i>Dama dama</i>	rare
Roe Deer	<i>Capreolus capreolus</i>	common
Chinese Water Deer	<i>Hydropotes inermis</i>	common
Reeves' Muntjac	<i>Muntiacus reevesi</i>	common
Whiskered Bat	<i>Myotis mystacinus</i>	just one bat detector record: Cley 28th August 1994 (Brandt's Bat not eliminated)
Daubenton's Bat	<i>Myotis daubentonii</i>	scarce
Natterer's Bat	<i>Myotis nattereri</i>	scarce
Serotine Bat	<i>Eptesicus serotinus</i>	scarce
Noctule	<i>Nyctalus noctula</i>	common
Common Pipstrelle	<i>Pipistrellus pipistrellus</i>	common
Soprano Pipstrelle	<i>Pipistrellus pygmaeus</i>	abundant
Nathusius' Pipistrelle	<i>Pipistrellus nathusii</i>	scarce
Barbastelle Bat	<i>Barbastella barbastellus</i>	scarce

Brown Long-eared Bat	<i>Plecotus auritus</i>	scarce
Parti-coloured Bat	<i>Vespertilio murinus</i>	just one record: Kelling Hard on 13th September 2008 (NBMR 2008: 178)
Common Seal	<i>Phoca vitulina</i>	common
Grey Seal	<i>Halichoerus grypus</i>	abundant
Harp Seal	<i>Pagophilus groenlandicus</i>	just one reported dead on Blakeney Point on 27th March 1988 (NBMR 1989: 480)
Humpback Whale	<i>Megaptera novaeangliae</i>	just one record: off Kelling Hard on 12th April 2015 (NBMR 2015: 210)
Minke Whale	<i>Balaenoptera acutorostrata</i>	just two records: off Cley Beach on 30th August & 14th September 2015 (NBMR 2015: 209)
Sowerby's Beaked Whale	<i>Mesoplodon bidens</i>	just one record: one live-stranded on Blakeney Point on 13th August 2009 (NBMR 2009: 187)
Long-finned Pilot Whale	<i>Globicephala melas</i>	just one record: a pod of 23 off Cley East Bank on 10th September 2014 (NBMR 2014: 178)
White-beaked Dolphin	<i>Lagenorhynchus albirostris</i>	just two records: singles found dead on Blakeney Point in March 1968 and on 23rd October 2010 (NBMR 2010: 216)
Harbour Porpoise	<i>Phocoena phocoena</i>	scarce
